ONLINE PROGRAMS

In addition to COVID-19 negative impact on all courses schedule, every crisis also offers opportunities - even for Outdoored.

During a time when it was impossible to implement our onsite courses, we challenge to prepare an online form of our main course topics.

The result is one online program for teachers called - **Learning by playing in nature** and one online program for school principals and leaders called - **Strategy and management for school development**.

Already over fifty participants from 15 countries in Europe and the USA took part in both courses. We plan to implement these programs regularly every month. In addition to a large number of quality materials, online programs also include live online meetings of participants and sharing experiences on other platforms.




OUTDOOR LEARNING WEBINARS

Another new regular activity which started during COVID crisis are regular webinars focusing on outdoor learning.

Webinars are open and free, run every 1 - 2 months. This an hour-long program consists of a "drop" of theory, a presentation of practical activities, an interview with an interesting guest experienced in outdoor learning and education, a visit to some European school and finally answering questions from the audience by our guests.

We run already 5 webinars with an experienced and interesting guest: Britta Brügge - Sweden, Joe Pavelka - Canada, Bernard Joyce - Ireland, Anders Szczepanski - Sweden and Juliet Robertson - UK.


